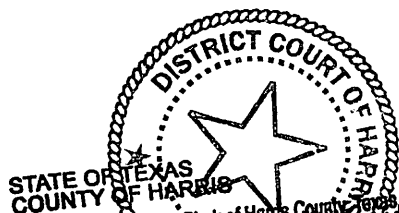

On June 29, 2017, the Court heard extensive arguments on various Pleas to the Jurisdiction filed by Defendants City of Houston, Kelly Dowe, Chris Brown and Certain Defendants and heard the Plaintiff Houston Firefighters' Relief and Retirement Fund's Application for Temporary Injunction. On June 30, 2017, the Court granted the Plea to the Jurisdiction presented by Defendants City of Houston, Kelly Dowe, Chris Brown and Certain Defendants. While the Court believes those Pleas were properly granted and the cases properly dismissed, in the alternative, should the dismissal found to have been granted in error, the Court enters this Order on Plaintiff Houston Firefighters' Relief and Retirement Fund's Application for Temporary Injunction.

The Court finds that Houston Firefighters' Relief and Retirement Fund has failed to satisfy its burden necessary for injunctive relief. Plaintiff Houston Firefighters' Relief and Retirement Application for Temporary Injunction is, therefore, DENIED.
